- HOW OFTEN. ¿Con qué frecuencia?. Suele utilizarse cuando lo subrayado en la respuesta es un adverbio (always, never, rarely...) o expresión que indica frecuencia (every, once/twice a..., weekly/monthly
 - I go to the cinema twice a week. How often do you go to the cinema?
- HOW LONG. ¿(Durante) cuánto tiempo?. La respuesta indica "duración": for 3 years, since I was a child, 2 weeks

I have been living here for 3 months. How long have you been living here?
