

## QUESTIONS TO ANSWERS

Question word	Examples
<i>Who</i> <b>¿QUIÉN?</b>	Who do you work with? / Who are you? I work with <b>my father</b> /I am <b>Nick</b>
<i>Where</i> <b>¿DÓNDE?</b>	Where are you from? I am from <b>Spain</b>
<i>When</i> <b>¿CUANDO?</b>	When were you born? I was born in <b>1978</b>
<i>Whose</i> <b>¿DE QUIÉN?</b>	Whose book is this?/Whose is this book? This is <b>Mike's</b> book/ This is <b>Mike's</b> book
<i>Why</i> <b>¿POR QUÉ?</b>	Why are you alone? <b>Because my father is visiting my brother</b>
<i>What</i> <b>¿QUÉ? ¿CUÁL?</b>	What is your telephone number? My telephone number is <b>98765443</b>
<i>What time</i> <b>¿(A) QUÉ HORA?</b>	What time does the train leave? The train leaves <b>at 10.00</b>
<i>What colour</i> <b>¿(DE) QUÉ COLOR?</b>	What colour do you prefer? I prefer <b>black colour</b>
<i>What kind of</i> <b>¿QUÉ CLASE DE?</b>	What kind of music do you like? I like <b>jazz</b>
<i>What/Who... for</i> <b>¿PARA QUÉ/QUIÉN?</b>	Who is she working for? She is working <b>for her father</b> What is a knife used for? It is used <b>for cutting</b>
<i>How</i> <b>¿CÓMO?</b>	How do you go to work? I go to work <b>by train</b>
<i>How many</i> <b>¿CUANTOS/AS?</b> <i>(nombres contables)</i>	How many books have you got? I have got <b>23 books</b>
<i>How much</i> <b>¿CUÁNTO/A?</b> <i>(nombres incontables)</i> <b>¿CUÁNTO CUESTA?</b>	How much water do you drink a day? I drink <b>a lot of</b> water How much does your car cost? My car costs <b>10000 pounds</b>
<i>How often</i> <b>¿CON QUÉ FRECUENCIA?</b> <b>¿CUÁNTAS VECES?</b>	How often do you go to school? I go to school <b>every day</b>
<i>How long</i> <b>¿(DURANTE) CUÁNTO TIEMPO?</b>	How long does it take to build a house? It takes <b>3 years</b> to build a house How long have you been waiting here? I have been waiting here <b>for 2 hours</b>
<i>How far</i> <b>¿A QUÉ DISTANCIA?</b>	How far is Madrid from Toledo? Madrid is <b>74 kilometres</b> from Toledo
<i>How old</i> <b>¿QUÉ EDAD...?</b>	How old are you? I am <b>54 years old</b>
<i>How wide?</i> <b>¿CUÁNTA ANCHURA...?</b>	How wide is your car? My car is <b>2 metres</b> wide

- **WHOSE:** WHOSE + COSA POSEÍDA+VERBO+SUJETO. Se utiliza siempre que la parte subrayada en la respuesta es un genitivo sajón o un pronombre posesivo. Significa "de quién"  
 This is Mary's car. Whose car is this?  
 This car is hers. Whose is this car?  
 This is Mary's car. Whose is this?
- **HOW OFTEN.** ¿Con qué frecuencia?. Suele utilizarse cuando lo subrayado en la respuesta es un adverbio (always, never, rarely...) o expresión que indica frecuencia (every, once/twice a..., weekly/monthly)  
 I go to the cinema twice a week. How often do you go to the cinema?
- **HOW LONG.** ¿(Durante) cuánto tiempo?. La respuesta indica "duración": for 3 years, since I was a child, 2 weeks  
 I have been living here for 3 months. How long have you been living here?
